Lundin Petroleum's statement

"We appreciate the opportunity to comment on the Swedwatch report because – consistent with the report's themes of dialogue, transparency and cooperation – we have always engaged transparently and openly with stakeholders, including investors, about our historic operations in Sudan and continue to do so.

The report repeats previous allegations which we have already fully addressed and continue to refute. It also contains certain misleading and inaccurate information about our activities in Sudan. We remain convinced that there are no legal or other grounds for any allegations of wrongdoing against any representative of Lundin and believe that our co-operation with the preliminary investigation by a Swedish Prosecutor will show that.

Lundin has always been an advocate for peace by peaceful means in Sudan. We have endorsed the UNGPs, we take responsibility to respect human rights seriously and we have always conducted business in an appropriate way, in accordance with existing standards.
